SUPERVISOR COMMENTS

Officers were proactive between calls for service, making several warrant arrests and an arrest for a weapon violation. Officers also responded to an armed robbery in-progress at a gas station. A male walked in the store with a handgun and demanded money from the

cashier. The suspect fled with about \$400, and based on surveillance evidence, got into a vehicle that was parked in a nearby neighborhood. The clerk locked himself in the restroom until police arrived and could not provide very much description of the suspect. Video surveillance shows a tall male with a medical mask on covering his face and a hoody over his head. A BOL was put out for CHP and surrounding agencies. A couple of hours later we received a call that CHP had the vehicle stopped with two males detained in Modesto. At the time of this log, an officer had responded to meet with CHP and was investigating the robbery further.
